Cindy Says: "Enough is enough! Too many of our sons and daughters are being killed for the neo-cons and their lies in a war for corporate greed."



Since the death of her 24 year old son Casey in Iraq in April 2004, she has emerged as one of the leading figures of the anti-war movement in the United States. She is the co-founder of Gold Star Families for Peace and a member of Voters for Peace. Cindy Sheehan has a righteous reputation for activism including protesting outside President Bush's estate in Crawford Texas. Sheehan was arrested and removed from the House gallery during Bush's State of the Union address after taking her seat and unveiling a T-shirt with an anti-war message. The shirt read: "2,245 dead. How Many More?"
