

Obama's Message to New Mexico

A New Kind of Campaign

- The Campaign for Change is building a different kind of organization – based on people talking to their own neighbors.
- Creating "Neighborhood Teams" volunteers trained, equipped, and empowered to build a campaign organization in their own neighborhood.
- Put change in the hands of every New Mexican

How Do Neighborhood Teams Work?

- Teams run the campaign outreach effort in their community, including:
 - Organizing voter contact (door-to-door/phones)
 - Voter registration
 - Recruit Vote-by-Mail applications
 - Native American outreach at feast days, parades and doorto-door at Chapter Houses
 - Develop constituency programs and recruit New Mexico veterans, educators, students and rural community volunteers
 - Organizing house meetings

Neighborhood Teams – By the Numbers

- Recruiting hundreds of CFC Neighborhood Teams throughout NM – unprecedented organizing effort in size, scope, and use of online tools to mobilize volunteers.
- About <u>4-6</u> precincts per team/neighborhood (in rural regions teams will organize part of their county)
- A Neighborhood Team will cover every precinct in the state

Training the Teams

 Our field staff will work with each team, and set weekly goals for them -- # of voters reached, registration forms collected, etc.

 Over 1600 volunteers across New Mexico have attended a CFC Neighborhood Team Training
